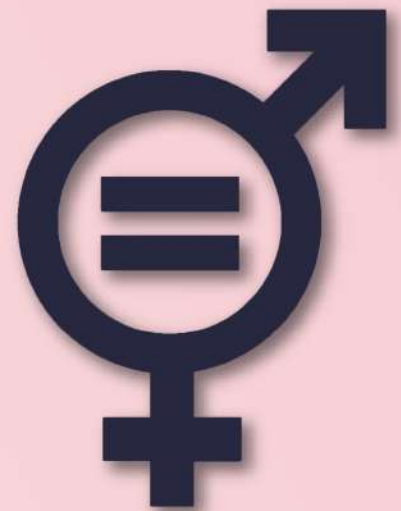

ASEAN Youth Initiative Conference 2021 will address certain Goals of the SDGs, specifically :

■ ***SDG 5: Gender Equality***

SDG 5 focuses on achieving gender equality and empowering all women and girls. It aims to eliminate discrimination against women and girls, also achieve equality between women and men as partners and beneficiaries of development, human rights, humanitarian action, peace, and security. Based on the UN Women statement, there are still many reports about the inequality between women and men that happened across the globe.

Women and girls experience intimate partner violence, become subject to various forms of harmful practices, carry a disproportionate share as the result of unpaid care and domestic work, and are underrepresented in leadership and management level positions in the public and private sectors.



■ ***SDG 8: Decent Work & Economic Growth***

SDG 8 focuses on promoting sustained, inclusive, and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all. The targets include promoting entrepreneurship and reducing the proportion of youth which are not in any employment, education, or training. According to the UNDESA report, people are looking towards entrepreneurship as a key component in the inclusion of youth into the labour market by supporting the development of youth-led enterprises, supporting new enterprises growth to create jobs that employ young people, and enhancing youth employment prospects.



■ ***SDG 13: Climate Action***

SDG 13 focuses on taking urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts towards the world we're living in. One of the targets is to improve education and awareness on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction, and early warning. The change of climate will affect the availability of basic necessities which can be redressed by coping with the anticipated shocks to the social, economic, and natural systems.

In the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, Member States gave a commitment to protect the planet from degradation and climate change that were identified as the greatest challenges of the time. Given any concern, they called for the widest cooperation and participation of all countries in an effective and appropriate international response to climate change.



■ ***SDG 16: Peace, Justice, & Strong Institutions***

SDG 16 focuses on promoting peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, providing access to justice for all and building effective, accountable, and inclusive institutions at all levels. The targets include promoting the rule of law at any level, ensuring equal access to justice for all, and developing effective, accountable, and transparent institutions at all levels, and ensuring public access to information and protecting fundamental freedoms, in accordance with national legislation and international agreements. Freedom of speech and freedom of expression are indispensable for the achievement of these targets and also in line with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in building peaceful, just and inclusive societies.

Opening CEREMONY



On the first day of the event, delegates and participants will attend the opening ceremony where there will be opening remarks from Padjadjaran University representatives and AYIC committees as an inauguration of the ASEAN Youth Initiative Conference 2021. The purpose of this agenda is to introduce the agenda to the participants and delegates. Furthermore, there will be a webinar in which keynote speakers will share their experiences and ideas regarding the respective topics at the youth level. The opening ceremony will also be commemorated with ASEAN's anthem and flag ceremony with the intention of uniting diversities in ASEAN member states.

Parallel Paper PRESENTATION

In Parallel Paper Presentation, distinguished delegates will present their own paper and ideas which have been submitted to the committees before the conference. Delegates will present their own paper using powerpoint in a chamber meeting. This activity is expected to engage discussions upon the delegate's paper. At the end of the first day, delegates also get personal feedback from the reviewer regarding their paper in the Paper Clinics session. Similar to the purpose of this event, this agenda is dedicated to improving the delegate's paper and their perspective on how they write their papers.



Initiative Forum DISCUSSION

Distinguished delegates will discuss their ideas about the respectful topics to solve the problems. The activity will start with a presentation from an expert in which they present the respective problems and then followed by an open discussion in the chamber meeting. Flow of the discussion will be guided by the moderator and Conference Management team. This agenda will focus on discussing and solving the particular problems. At the end of the discussion, all delegates will work together to turn their ideas into action plans from SDGs perspective. This would initiate all delegates to determine the strategy, possible solutions, youth roles, and also policy recommendation on particular targets of the SDGs.



Public CONFERENCE

This agenda will be free of charge and open for public participants. The purpose of this agenda is to not limit the young delegates or participants who don't join as a formal delegate yet have a keen interest in SDGs at the youth level. This agenda is expected to engage youth enthusiasts upon the SDGs, in particular at the ASEAN scope. Afterwards, there would be a presentation in each chamber at the end of the forum discussion.



AYIC VISIT

The agenda of AYIC visit is dedicated to introducing AYIC by inviting Student Executive Board and Student Associations to speak up their ideas regarding the topics that will be discussed in AYIC 2021. The participants will be focused on the Student Executive Board and Student Association. AYIC would send an invitation to all parties to attend the open discussion.



Delegates NIGHT

This agenda is established to create a friendly interaction between and with all delegates in an informal setting. Delegates Night is an attempt to loosen formal feelings in the conference as one of AYIC objectives to broaden networking for all delegates. Delegates Night will be done with ice breaking interactions and will be finished with the awarding session and closing ceremony. Awards will be given to each winning delegate from each chamber and will be watched by all delegates and staff.
