




✓ Internship Opportunities [YSIP, Yonsei Summer Internship Program] (CORPORATE/RESEARCH)

YISS offers various internship positions exclusively for YISS students. Through various companies and research centers, students can explore and experience the real working life.

Corporate Internship offers YISS students direct exposure to global corporate settings in the heart of Seoul, Korea.

Research Internship offers the opportunity to participate in research projects or work as an intern in research centers or organizations at Yonsei University.

Summer Internship Program is only available for students who are registered to YISS. YSIP is organized as an unpaid academic course, from which participants will earn 2 credits. To apply for an internship position provided by YSIP, students are required to be enrolled at least two courses including YSIP.

Extracurricular Activities

The exciting learning environment of YISS continues outside the classroom with a variety of extracurricular activities. Including DMZ tour, Korean cooking class, and many more. YISS offers students an introduction to Korean history, culture and scenic landscape with opportunities to meet and interact with other students.

Eligibility & Application Materials

- 1 YISS is open to ALL STUENTS currently enrolled in an accredited college or university.
 - *Rquired document: Official transcript with GPA over 2.0/4.0
 - *Freshmen, whose transcripts are not issued yet, can submit Certificate of Enrollment, instead.
- 2 High school seniors who have been accepted to accredited colleges or universities can apply.
 - *Required document: Letter of Admission from accredited college or university

Application Procedures

- 1 Create an ID and Complete Online Application on YISS website (summer.yonsei.ac.kr)
- 2 Upload required documents on the application
- 3 Pay the Application Fee
- 4 Wait for Admission Review to be done
- 5 Receive Acceptance Letter via email
- Complete Enrollment by paying the Tuition Fee and Other Fees
- (Optional) Apply for On-Campus Housing (Application: Early-April)
- **7** Upload Insurance Document on Application System

Credit Transfer

Minimum: 1 Course (3 Credits) Maximum: 3 Courses (9 Credits)

All YISS courses are credit-bearing courses. Credits earned at YISS are transferable to most institutions outside of Korea. For credit transfer, students are advised to consult and obtain approval from their academic advisors of home institutions in advance. Credit transferability of a particular YISS course depends solely on home institutions' policies.

On-Campus Housing

Because On-Campus Housing is not guaranteed for all students due to the limited availability, housing is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students are strongly recommended to apply for housing as soon as possible through the housing website (dorm.yonsei.ac.kr/en) after receiving your acceptance email.

The Center of Traditional Culture

The Heart of Seoul

Yonsei University is located in the center of the capital city of South Korea, Seoul, where you can witness a variety of traditional Korean culture. In addition to Korea's first Western health institution, Gwanghyewon which is located within the university, there are other nearby sites where you can experience traces of the 500-year history of the Joseon Dynasty, such as Deoksu-gung, Changdeok-gung, and Gyeongbok-gung. These sites are located only 15 minutes away from campus so that students may easily seek out these opportunities to experience Korea's traditional culture. The New York Times selected Seoul as one of the top three "must visit" cities of the world.
