Since September 2009, Deutsche Welle, Germany's international broadcaster is offering the Master's Program "International Media Studies". The bilingual, full-time program for further education combines topics like media and development, journalism, communication science and media economics, whilst developing skills and competencies that are important for the world of the media. This practice-oriented program optimally prepares graduates for a career in the international media industry.

The Master's Program is a joint project from the University of Bonn, the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences and Deutsche Welle. DW-Akademie, Deutsche Welle's international training institute, offers a perfect environment for learning and training for up to 30 students per year.

The duration of the program is four semesters. The students conclude the course with a master's thesis and colloquium. Successful graduates receive a Master of Arts (M.A.).

Successful applicants must have a bachelor's degree or an equivalent qualification as well as one year of professional experience in a media-related field after having obtained their B.A.. In addition, they need to provide proof of their language skills in both German and English.

Tuition will cost a total of 6,000 €. There are a limited number of scholarships available for applicants from developing and transition countries. Deadline for applications is March 31st, 2016.
