Each module consists of 10 sessions, featuring a combination of online materials and live interactive sessions with University of Warwick tutors. The 10 sessions will be delivered every weekday over each of the two-week schools. These live interactive sessions will include all 16 participants in the group and employ breakout groups for discussion activities and to facilitate task completion. The programme will also feature an online discussion forum moderated by the Director of Studies and group work leading towards an end of programme presentation.
